



# Coal Creek OHV Area Trail of the Month June 2011 Trail 20



**Difficulty Level:** Slightly Moderate

**Vehicles:** Open to all OHVs

**Location:** Wolf Ridge



**Directions:** From the parking lot, follow P1 to G2. Follow G2 for a short distance, then turn left onto G20. From G20, Trail 20 will be just beyond the turn for Trail 4, Trail 20 will be on the right. Once on Trail 20, you will come to the first fork. The right fork is more challenging, the left fork is much easier and even suitable for younger or less experienced riders- both forks will intersect the trail on the upper level. The upper level is a loop around the top of the mountain. Regardless of which fork you take, go left once you are on the upper level. On the eastern side of the ridge, Trail 20a will fork off and go to the very top of the ridge.





**Features:** Trail 20 is a less traveled trail, but one that should not be missed. The trail offers many beautiful overlooks- magnificent colors in the Fall- with views of Flagpole Knob, Big Fodderstack, Little Fodderstack and other mountains and valleys beyond Coal Creek OHV Area boundaries. The upper level follows an old coal seam which was mined decades ago, thus providing the perfect place for a trail. Some mud holes are deep, but most have a solid rock bottom and are no trouble,

just use caution. One large area on the southeastern side of the trail has many shallow puddles and is used by many frogs, toads and salamanders for breeding areas. Egg sacks are always plentiful in the spring and are a sight to see! The rock formations along this trail are beautiful and riders should take some time to enjoy the beauty of this trail.
