



Coal Creek OHV Area Trail of the Month September 2011 Trail 28



Difficulty Level: Difficult

Vehicles: Open to all ATVs. No Trucks, Jeeps or Buggies.

Location: Bullskin Ridge

Directions: From the Windrock parking lot, follow Trail 2 to Trail 16 on the right. Follow Trail 16 to Trail 18 on the right. Follow Trail 18 to Trail 28 on the right.

Features: Trail 28 is located on the southern portion of the property and is approximately 3.1 miles long. Trail 28 starts by traveling down a rocky section of trail near Bullskin Creek. This trail has some beautiful rocks and boulders. The creeks are currently dry, but have some neat ledges and drops. This trail has a few options for riders. There are some sections of the trail where you may take the high side or the low side.



These end up at the same place,

but one way may be more difficult than the other. For the less experienced riders, this trail can be completed, but take your time and plan your route. The trail travels through Coal Creek's typical hardwood forest, but once in the Lick Ridge area, there is an abundance of young pine stands- a rarity on this property! Keep an eye out for muscadines in these areas! The vines are some of the only remaining evidence of homesteads from long ago in this area. Once at the end of Trail 28, Trail 30, to the right, is a scenic loop along Mill Creek. Trail 29, to the left, is a short cut to the top of the ridge, cutting off part of Trail 30. Enjoy the September Trail of the Month!
